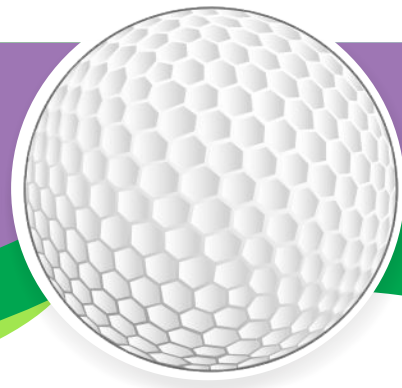

## *Golf Tip from the Pro:*

### **Hold the Angle for Power**

The best way to improve your ball striking and distance is to hold the angle created by your wrist toward the golf ball.

The longer you can achieve this, the more power you can deliver to the golf ball creating tremendous power, spin, more penetrating ball flight & more accuracy.

If you look in the leading golf magazines or a golf telecast on television and when they breakdown a tour player's swing, really focus on their transition from the backswing to the impact position. What they are doing is that they are trying to compress the golf ball. This term "compression" is the outcome of the flight, distance, and spin created on the golf ball.

This is why you see so many tour players launching the ball well over 300 yards and they create a lot of backspin on the golf ball when it hits the green.

The next time you're at the practice tee, try to focus on holding the angle of your wrists from the backswing to the golf ball by doing the following:

- Start with a Pitching Wedge
- Swing to the top of your backswing
- Focus on swinging the butt end of the club to the ball

You will find that your ball flight will flatten and have more control of your golf ball.
